Prior to turning on a Ricoh MFP / printer

- Wipe the entire device's exterior with a dry cloth to prevent damage caused by dust.
- If there is paper in the paper tray(s), replace all with brand new paper.
- Remove the All-In-One (AIO) unit and shake side to side 4 - 5 times.

Power up the device by turning on the main power switch

- On color printing devices, perform Auto Color Calibration and Color Registration according to the User Manual.
- Perform a test print of about 10 sheets to check the operation and print quality. If a peripheral is installed, also test other functions, such as stapling, punching, etc.
- Run at least 10 sheets of paper from each paper source tray.
